 - In early discussions with RCAP/GLCAP to get a proper rate study completed, to get a GIS system in place, and to complete our required Asset Management Plan. These 3 projects go hand-in-hand.
 - Still waiting for additional street repair quotes
 - Still waiting for additional door widening quotes for the Water Plant
 - o Working on quotes for replenishing mulch at the park playground on Chicago Ave

Jessi had a quote for a new door for the chemical room. She a new door had been installed but it was not EPA compliant. The new door must have a window with wire, so the room is able to be observed. Council would like several more quotes.

She also said we have an EPA violation because the storage needs inspected.

She is also working on an OPWC grant. This would be for the six valves, 3 on either side of the tracks. The project would be around \$126,000.00. The grant would pay 80% and the Village 20%.
